Cross Country Training with Caz Mosley

At Edderston Farm XC Course, Peebles, EH45 9JE

This training will take place over Edderston Farm XC course near Peebles. The course has three heights at most fences ranging from approx 50cm to 1m. Groups limited to 4 riders and will last 1.5 hours approx..

Both horse and rider must be correctly dressed for cross country riding. Riders must wear current BRC/BHS/BE standard hat with no fixed peaks and body protector BETA level 3 (purple label with year 2000 or 2009) for this XC training.

Please note that there will be no paramedic cover but the instructor is a First Aider and by booking this training, you indicate that you are happy and prepared to continue with no paramedic cover.

Please note NO DOGS ALLOWED. Anyone breaking this rule, will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

Costs £45-00 per horse and rider (which includes course hire)

Vaccinations: All horses must be up to date with their yearly vaccinations in line with BRC/BE rules. Please send a photo or copy of this with your booking form.

Cancellations: Any cancellations or withdrawals received within 72 hours of the clinic will be refunded minus £15. No refund will be given if within 24 hours of the clinic, unless the event is cancelled or your space is re-allocated.

Directions to Edderston Cross Country

Edderston Farm, Peebles EH45 9JE

Location: OS Landranger map 73 – Peebles / Galashiels and surrounding area. Ref. NT 242 395.

Edderston Farm is approached through Peebles. Do NOT approach the farm from the Manor direction as there's a very narrow bridge that has been blocked off to vehicles.

From Peebles High Street

If you are heading into Peebles passing the fuel station on your right and travelling down the high street you will come to the mini roundabout. Turn left and head over Tweed Bridge (southwards) and take the first right turning. Follow this road and you will come to a mini roundabout. Turn left onto Edderston Road. Follow this road up the hill and turn right after the end of the houses on the right-hand side. It is signposted to Edderston and Manor. Edderston Farm is the first farm on the left. Parking is at the back of the farm on the left so go past the archway and turn onto the large driveway on the left. Parking is in front of you beside the all weather outdoor arena.

Please park sensibly and clean up after yourself.
